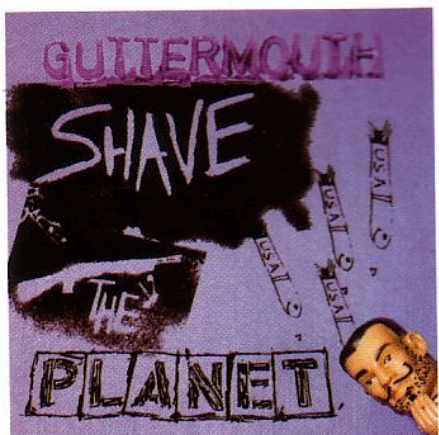

Guttermouth's onstage verbal abuse and rejection of liberalism led My Chemical Romance to petition for the band's removal from 2004's Warped Tour. The Gutterboys' gimmicky immaturity continues on *Shave the Planet*, with "shit-on-everything" tracks like the retaliatory "My Chemical Imbalance." Yet, moronic antics and closed-mindedness aside, unlike most modern punk bands, Guttermouth are still able to bang out 10 raucous tracks in 20 minutes without pretension. And if you don't like the record—as singer Mark Adkins would likely recommend—just turn it off and shut the fuck up. EF
